Dear Friends of Sts. Peter and Paul:

As the registration for the school year 2009-2010 is on its way, we want to inform you that Sts. Peter and Paul will be accepting the Florida P.R.I.D.E. Scholarship (CTC). Please, refer to the website [www.floridapride.org](http://www.floridapride.org) or call or come to our school office for more information. We will be happy to assist you.

As the website states, "To be eligible for a new scholarship (sibling add-ons or new applicants):

1. The household must complete the scholarship application and mail it along with **ALL** required supporting documentation listed on the application to the designated processing company.
2. The household must document that the household income qualifies for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program (185% of Federal Poverty Level). The household does not have to be participating in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program, but their income must qualify for it.
3. The student(s) must be 5 years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>, by law.
4. The student(s) must be:
  - Entering Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Public school attendance is not required for students entering K and 1<sup>st</sup> grades
  - OR
  - Entering 2<sup>nd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade and have attended a Florida public school for the entire prior school year, by law. By law, new students who have been attending a private school if entering 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or higher are not eligible to participate.
5. The household must not have been disqualified from the program for any reason, including internal audit process.

The Scholarship may be renewed every year through 12<sup>th</sup> grade as long as the household and student(s) continue to meet the conditions of eligibility."

We encourage you to further investigate this opportunity and we hope to see you at Sts. Peter and Paul School.
