Aftercare Program

2026-2027

The aftercare program follows all school policies and expectations with some additional specific to aftercare.

Program

The aftercare program at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School serves families who need care after the regular school day hours Monday through Friday. Students are supervised by counselors hired by the school. Students are afforded opportunities to complete home learning activities, read, play board games, watch movies, work on arts and crafts, and counselor-led physical activities outside throughout the week. Students who participate in the school's athletic program may participate in our AC program.

Students who are not picked up after school or after practices/games will **not** be sent to after care and will instead remain in the office for pickup. A fee may be incurred. Only students registered to aftercare will be allowed to attend.

Registration and Payments

Students are not accepted into the program without a registration form and payment. The program expects a waitlist; therefore, students will be registered on a first come-first served basis. The registration fee is \$75 for the year for anyone who participates for any amount of days/times. Registration does not roll over year to year. There are no refunds.

The aftercare monthly fee is \$275 or \$20 a day. All payments will be assessed and must be paid through FACTS according to your payment plan. Payments received late will be assessed a \$10 late fee. Failure to meet payments in a timely manner will result in withdrawal from the aftercare program. Students **MUST** be picked up by 6:00. A \$5 fee for

every 10 minutes of late pickup will be assessed after 6 p.m. Multiple late pick-ups will result in withdrawal from the program.

Food

We ask that students bring healthy snacks to be enjoyed during their designated snack time on the After Care schedule. On early release days, students must bring lunch from home or make sure they have funds in their account to purchase food from our cafeteria vendor.

There will be no delivery of food from family members or delivery services during aftercare hours.

Arrival and Dismissal

All aftercare students must be signed out and picked up by someone who has been identified on the Emergency Contact Card with proper ID for verification and present the school placard at the school. No student will be dismissed without proper identification/documentation by pick-up individual. Students who did not attend the last 3 hours of the school day cannot return to campus for aftercare.

Classes and Classrooms

Once students are placed in a class, they cannot be switched without administrative approval. All classes are made on a student/counselor ratio basis. Once the classrooms are locked for the day, they cannot be re-opened by any staff member. Students cannot return to their classrooms for any reason.

Withdrawal Process and Days of No Service

If your child is to be withdrawn from the program, the account must be paid in full by the time of withdrawal.

Although we do our best to keep these at a minimum, please know that there will be days throughout the school years that aftercare will not be open. These dates will be communicated in advance throughout the year.
