

SPPS Student-Athlete Athletic Contract



A fulfilling educational and athletic experience requires the exercise of responsibilities on the part of both personnel associated with the athletic program and student-athletes. As a student-athlete, I understand my responsibility to commit to the principles of academic standards, acceptable conduct, accountability and responsibility. Furthermore, I must commit to the principles of self-discipline, collaborative effort, team building, and to be an ambassador for Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School and the SPPS Athletic Program.

Academic Standards

The SPPS Athletic Department is committed to the philosophy that student-athletes are students first and foremost, and that all student-athletes must exhibit behaviors that demonstrate a commitment to maximizing academic success as their first priority. I understand that SPPS Athletics has created various standards, strategies, and policies to maximize the possibility of student-athletes meeting their academic goals. I understand that I am obligated to comply with these standards. The academic standards that must be upheld are as follows:

Student-athletes must have no less than a 2.0, C, or 70%, average in each class to participate in tryouts and participate in the SPP Athletic Program. This academic standard must be met throughout the entire school year. If one makes a team with the required academic standard but fails to maintain the academic standard during the season while participating in said sport, the student-athlete may be placed on academic probation or removed from the sport until the academic standard is met. When interims are released in the middle of the quarter, students must meet an academic standard of having no F grades on the interim, and no more than one D. If a grade of F is present, my participation in said sport will be nullified until I attain a grade of a C or higher. If placed on an academic contract at any point and time during a season, a time frame will be given to raise the grade to a C or higher.

All fees charged and associated with this sport will apply; the fees are not refundable nor transferrable should the terms and conditions of this aspect of SPPS Student-Athlete Athletic Contract not be met.

Conduct Standards

In addition to upholding the ADOM Responsibilities and Code of Conduct Contract, student-athletes must also adhere to the SPPS rules of code and conduct in school, during practices, and on the field or court. Any student-athlete who exhibits or says any prejudice, racial, or misogynistic comments in school, on the bus to and from games, and at or during a game or competition will be immediately disciplined. This could mean practice and game suspension to being removed from the team for the remainder of the season, to being removed from SPPS Athletics indefinitely. The punishment will come from the AD's and administration. Any student-athlete who cannot conduct himself or herself in accordance with SPPS conduct standards in school, during practices, and on the field or court will be immediately disciplined. This could mean practice and game suspension to being removed from the team for the remainder of the season, to being removed from SPPS Athletics indefinitely. The punishment will come from the AD's and administration.

All fees charged and associated with this sport will apply; the fees are not refundable nor transferrable should the terms and conditions of this aspect of SPPS Student-Athlete Athletic Contract not be met.

Nonrefundable Team Fees

Once a student makes a team and has even one practice with the team, parents are responsible for the sports fee. Once a student is on the roster, and it has been signed by Coach Moses or Coach Oharriz and the principal, the student is on the team. The sports fee must be paid, and there will be no refunds or prorations for the season. Only very extenuating circumstances would warrant a school credit being provided to parents.
