Uniform Guidelines

School uniforms are acceptable from Ibiley ONLY. Uniforms from stores such as Old Navy, Target, Walmart, etc. are not acceptable. The uniform store will guide you as to the type of clothing you need to buy. The website link with uniforms is posted above. Please note that uniforms for grades PreK and K-5 are different than those from the middle school uniforms for grades 6-8. Mass uniforms for 6-8 are to be worn on Fridays.

Guidelines:

- Plain black belts are always required for boys.
- Girls' skirt hems should fall at the **top of the knee**. Please monitor this as girls get taller throughout the year or may have grown from the previous year. **Note: It is not the uniform company's responsibility to monitor skirt length at purchase. Please purchase skirts at an appropriate length so that they meet requirements when school begins. Students will be asked to purchase a longer skirt if necessary.** Skirts may not be rolled up at the waist.



- On designated PE days, students may wear the yellow Sts. Peter and Paul P.E. shirt and blue Sts. Peter and Paul P.E. shorts (not to be worn tightly or short-- please purchase at the store accordingly). Shorts may not be rolled up at the waist. No other shirts/shorts will be allowed.
- Sneakers are only to be worn on P.E. days. No lighted sneakers are permitted.
- Shoes: All grades may wear black shoes such as penny loafers. Girls may wear MaryJane-style shoes and boys may wear strapped or laced black shoes (not athletic-wear). Strapped black sneakers may be worn for grades PreK 3 and 4 only.
- Only white over-the-ankle socks are allowed. No logos permitted.
- Sweaters/sweatshirts must be purchased from the uniform store. No other sweatshirts or sweaters will be allowed.
- Nail polish or unnatural nails are not permitted. Makeup will be removed immediately, and students will have until the next day to remove nail polish. Either of these are considered a uniform infraction.
- Dyed or highlighted hair is not permitted. No trendy haircuts for boys are permitted (including but not limited to faux hawks, mullets (shorter on the sides than the back), buzzed lines, or designs). Boy's hair must be cut above the collar and ear. The front must be cut at or over the eyebrows. It must be combed neatly. Any issue with inappropriate haircuts/hair dye must be remedied by the NEXT school day.
- Girls may wear ONE pair of small studs or ear-lobe huggers. Hoop or dangling earrings are not permitted for safety purposes. Boys may NOT wear earrings.
- Students may wear one thin gold/silver religious chain and one thin gold/silver bracelet. Costume jewelry, chokers, multiple bracelets, etc. are not allowed.
- Smart watches (Apple Watches, etc.) are not allowed. Black, gray, or navy regular style watches (noise-free) may be worn.
